### About Congressman Rehberg and Corporate Polluters.

- Mercury and lead compounds are both dangerous toxic pollutants, especially for young children.
- Forty-nine of Montana's waterways have been determined to be "impaired and threatened" due to mercury contamination.<sup>4</sup>
- Industries that produce these kinds of toxic pollutants have contributed at least \$175,450 to Congressman Rehberg.<sup>5</sup>
- Congressman Rehberg voted repeatedly to loosen protections against toxic air pollution.<sup>6</sup>
