Dissolve to headshot of Bush, driving

Dissolve to shot of off shore oil rig fire

George Bush to camera, greenery in background, which dissolves to A shot of an oil slicked beach. Bush then fades out, revealing a “Danger, Beach Closed” sign in the shot, CG: **Don’t Support Drilling off our Coast**
