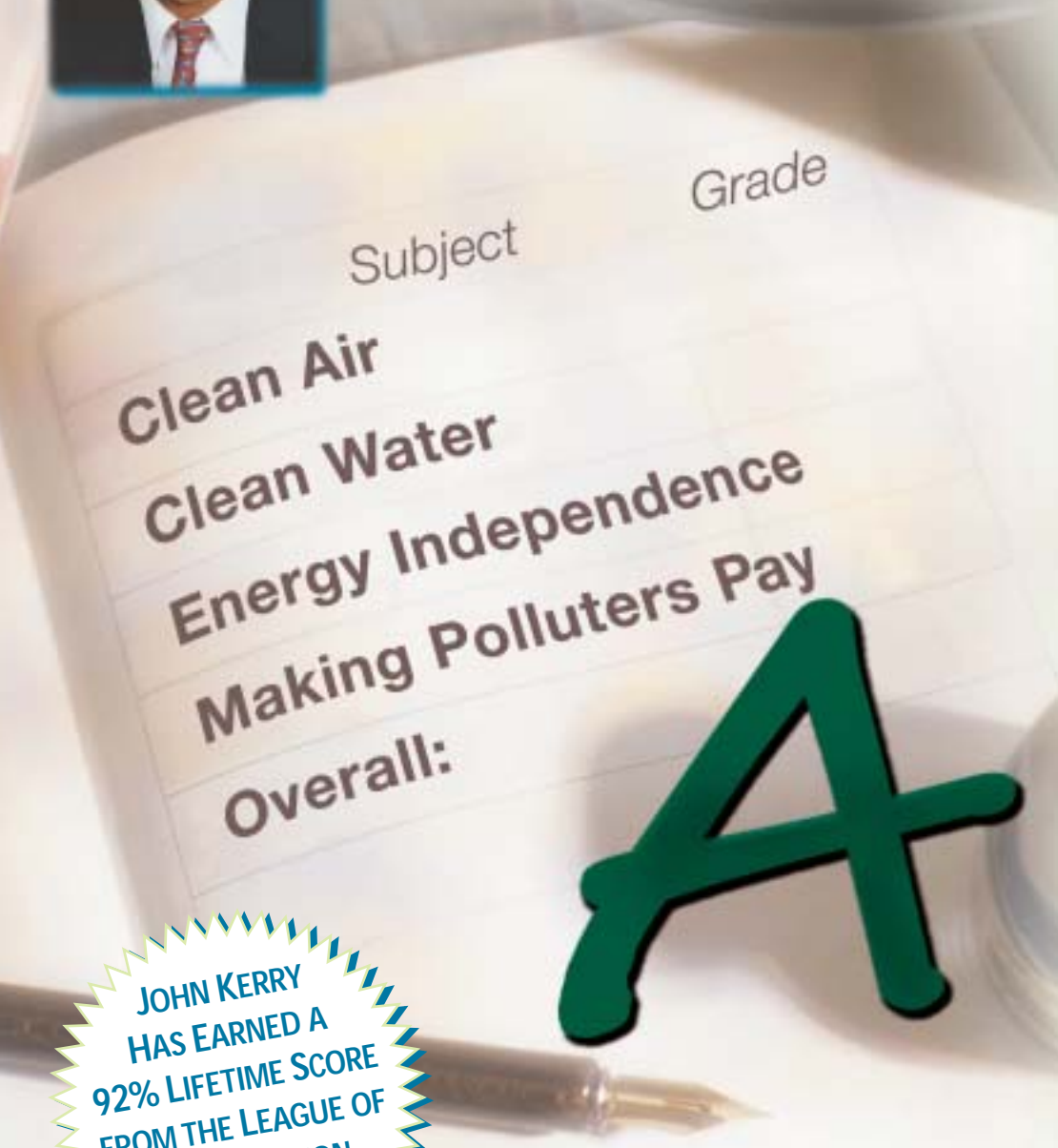
Kerry has been a leader in protecting our drinking water, and voted to strengthen enforcement of the Safe Drinking Water Act.³
