<b>CAROL MOSELEY BRAUN</b> LCV Lifetime Score: 80%	Worked to reduce toxic pollution in low-income urban neighborhoods	Supported nuclear energy, opposed drilling in the Arctic refuge
<b>GEORGE W. BUSH</b> 2003 LCV presidential report card: "F"	Received an "F" on his most recent LCV Presidential Report Card--the first failing grade given to a president in LCV's history	Proposed energy plan with clear bias towards corporate interests; pushed for drilling in Arctic refuge and other sensitive areas and greater use of polluting energy sources such as coal and nuclear power
<b>WESLEY CLARK</b>	Chairman of a company that has developed a fuel efficient propulsion system for cars	Advocates for energy efficient vehicles; supports higher fuel efficiency standards; opposes drilling in the Arctic refuge
<b>HOWARD DEAN</b>	Protected hundreds of thousands of acres of Vermont land; made a well-received campaign speech on environmental issues	As governor, created an energy efficiency program but supported nuclear power, opposes drilling in the Arctic refuge
<b>JOHN EDWARDS</b> LCV Lifetime Score: 76%	Led Senate opposition to Clean Air Act roll-backs	Supports a 10 percent renewable electricity standard, opposes drilling in the Arctic refuge
<b>DICK GEPHARDT</b> LCV Lifetime Score: 66%	Advocated including environmental safeguards in international trade agreements; proposed a comprehensive national energy policy--"Apollo 21"	Voted against higher fuel efficiency standards for cars and trucks, opposes drilling in the Arctic refuge
<b>JOHN KERRY</b> LCV Lifetime Score: 96%	Key player in recent Senate fights against drilling in the Arctic refuge; led fight to increase fuel efficiency of cars and trucks; made well-received campaign speeches on environmental and energy issues	Led fight to increase fuel efficiency of cars and trucks; key player in recent fights against drilling in the Arctic refuge
<b>DENNIS KUCINICH</b> LCV Lifetime Score: 90%	Opposes spread of genetically modified food and expansion of nuclear power	Opposes nuclear power expansion, supports higher fuel efficiency standards for cars and trucks, opposes drilling in the Arctic refuge
<b>JOE LIEBERMAN</b> LCV Lifetime Score: 93%	Led battles to protect Arctic refuge since first elected; pushing for mandatory cap and trade program for carbon emissions; made a noteworthy campaign speech on energy issues	Led fights against drilling in the Arctic refuge; supports higher fuel efficiency standards for cars and trucks, and "clean" coal and nuclear research
<b>AL SHARPTON</b>	Has called for action to end childhood lead poisoning in New York City	Supports higher fuel efficiency standards for cars and trucks and development of renewable energy
