This week, the House Committee on Energy and Commerce - of which you are a member -- is scheduled to vote on H.R. 745, a resolution asking the President of the United States to provide to the committee information on the membership and activities of the National Energy Policy Development Group.

As you know this group was formed by President Bush in early 2001 to develop a national energy policy, with Vice President Cheney at the helm. The Bush administration has also gone to court to prevent information being released about who participated in the group, who they met with, when they met, what information was provided to the group, or any documents related to their work. The legislation this task force influenced could cost taxpayers billions of dollars in the coming years, play a significant role in the security of our nation, and largely determine the quality of the air they breathe and the water they drink. The people of New Mexico anxiously await your opinions on this issue.

The League of Conservation Voters (LCV), the political voice of the national environmental movement, respectfully requests that you take a public stand on this issue by casting a vote on this key resolution.
