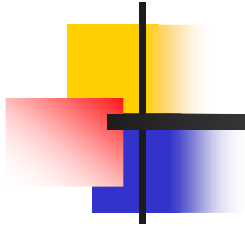

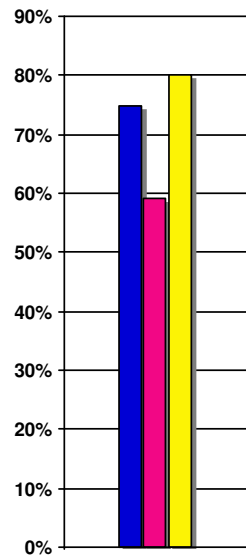
Methodology

Do you feel that it will result in:

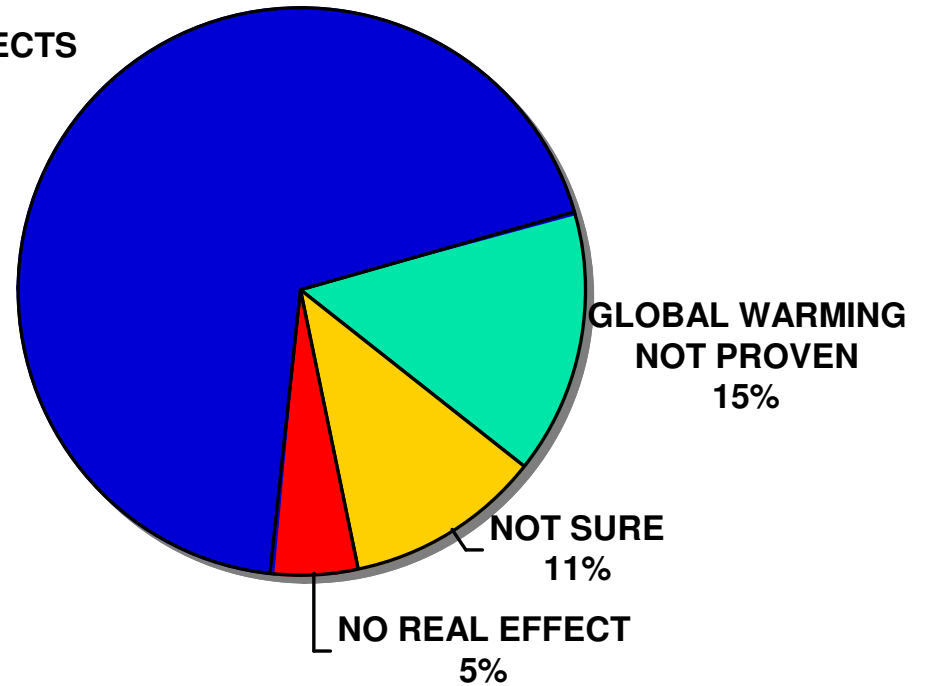

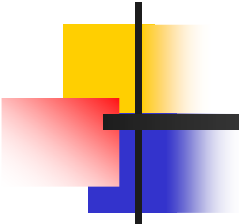

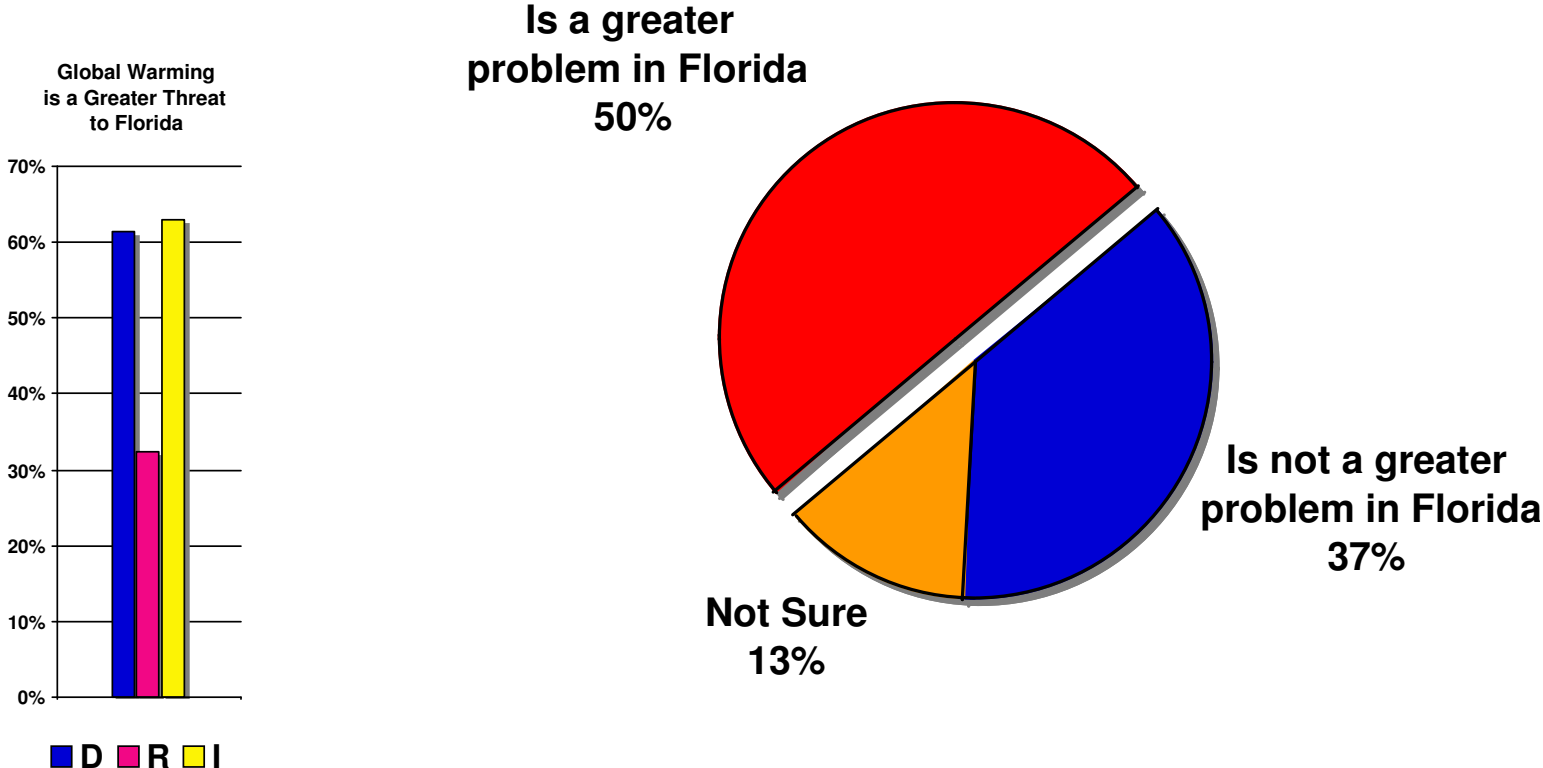

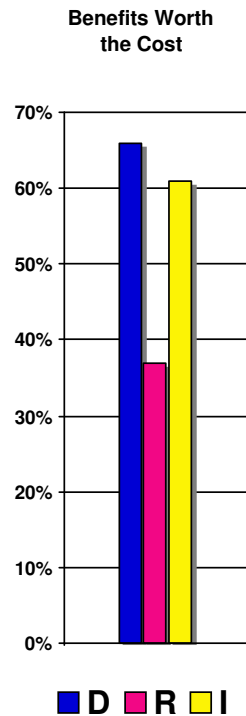




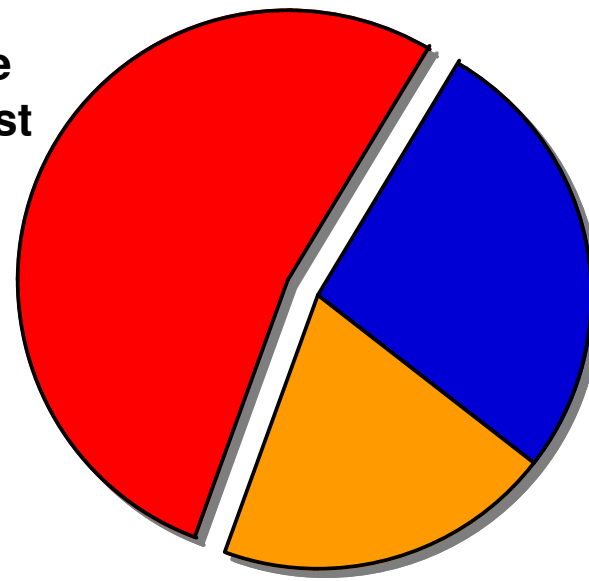
QUESTION: Compared to the rest of the Continental United States, do you feel that Global Warming is or is not a greater threat to Florida?



QUESTION: On the issue of Global Warming in Florida, do you feel that the benefits of taking action will:

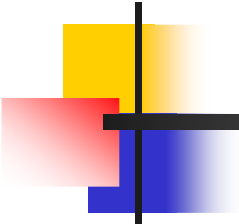

Do you agree or disagree with the Governor’s statement?

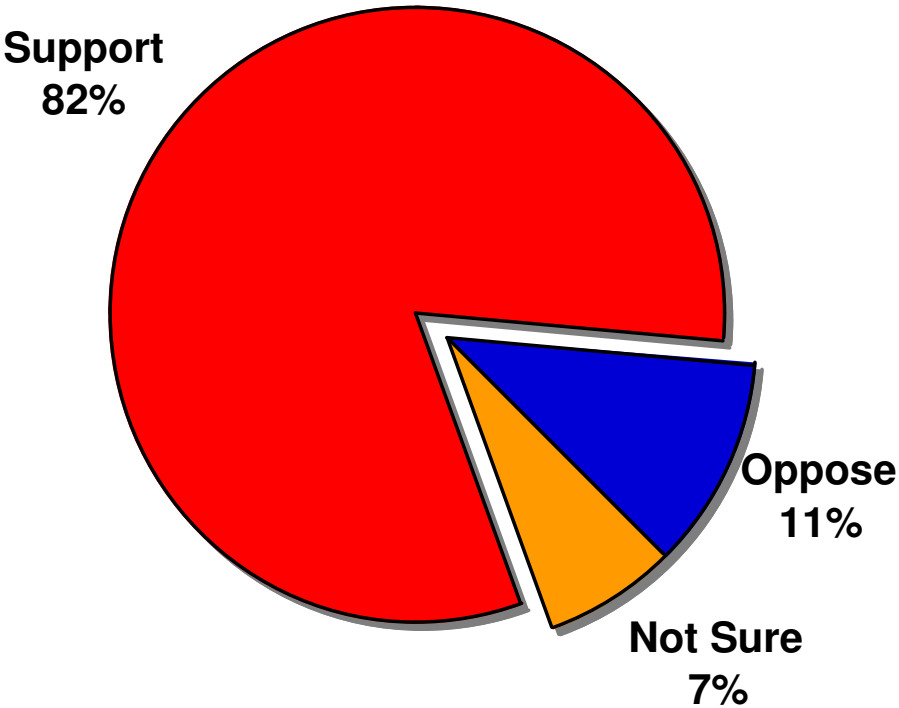
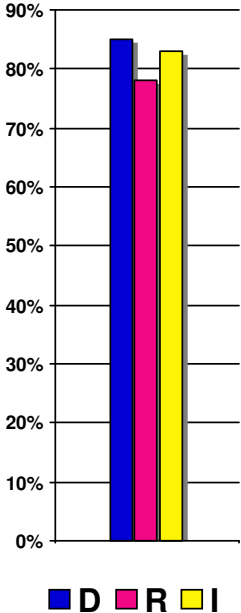

Do you support or oppose this goal?

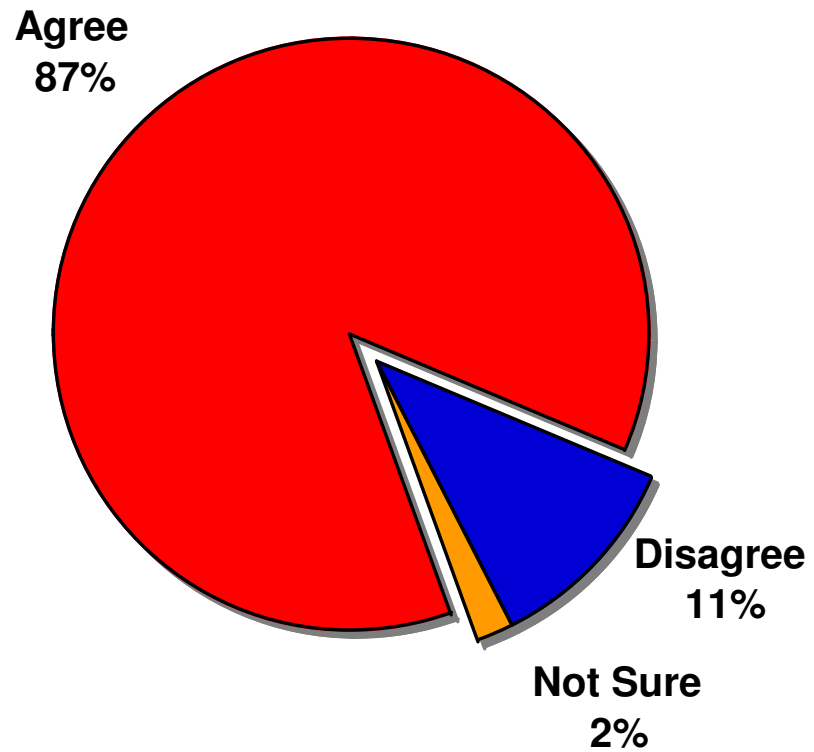
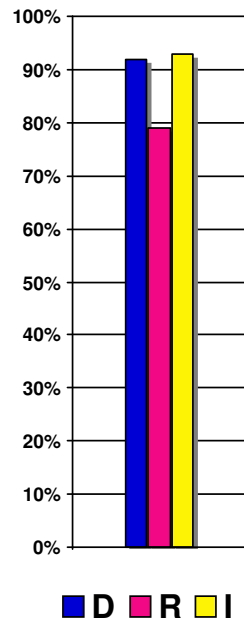
Support for Emmissions Reduction

Do you agree or disagree?

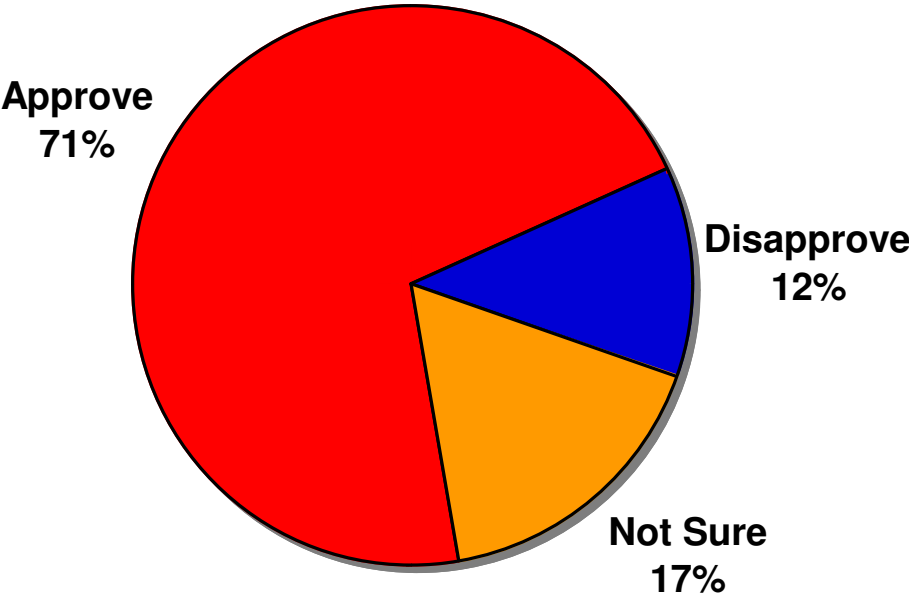
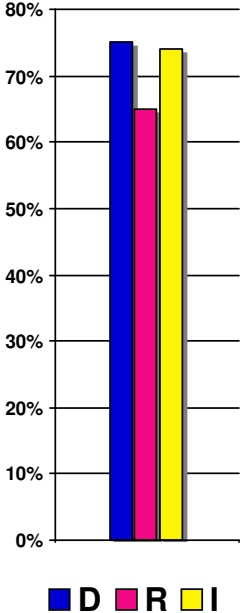
Agree: Solutions Require

Question: Governor Crist has proposed capping emissions from major greenhouse gas sources such as utility plants.

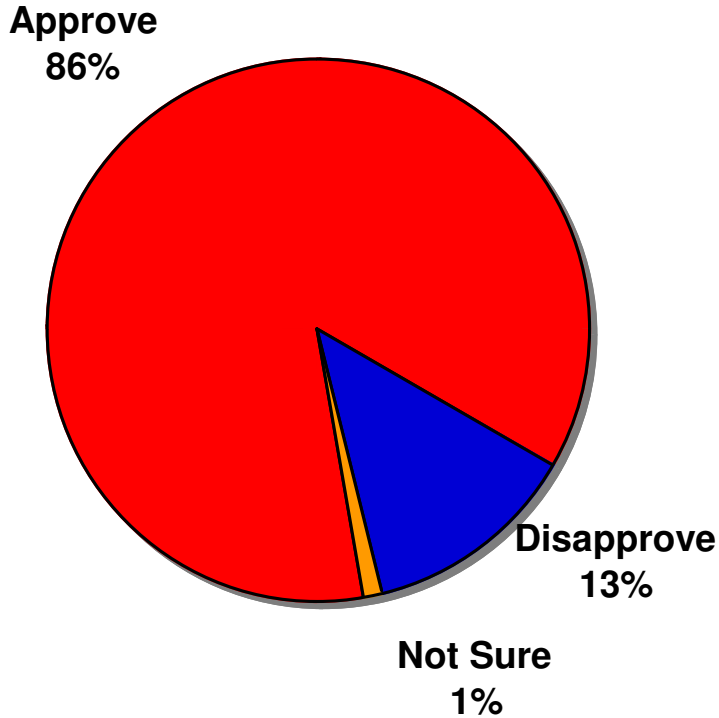
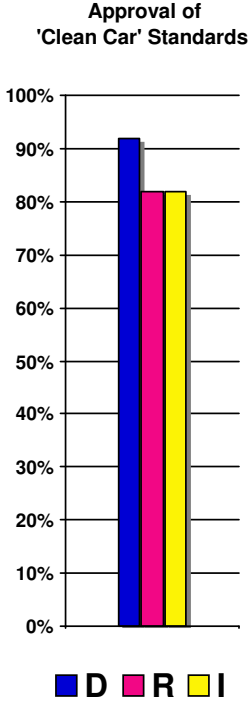
Do you approve or disapprove of this proposal?

Agree: Capping Emissions



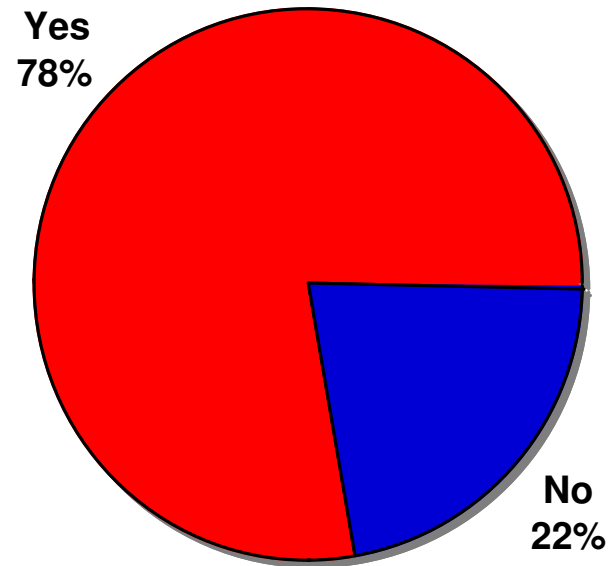
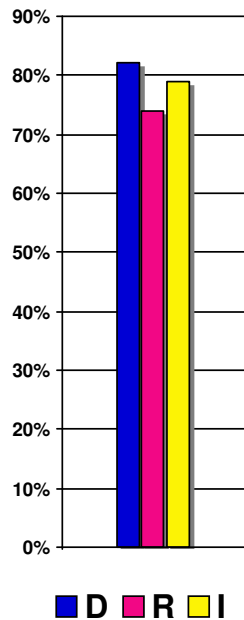
Question: Governor Crist has proposed adopting a “Clean Car Standard” to require new cars sold in Florida to be more fuel efficient.
