To: The Senate Democratic Caucus

Dear Democratic Senator,

We thank you and your staff for having worked tirelessly in the reconciliation process to advance critical priorities that would move the nation forward, including on clean energy, environmental justice, high-quality jobs, and healthcare.

We write today to urge you to not give up hope for congressional action on climate and to do everything in your power, which includes continued efforts to find consensus within the caucus as well as control of the Senate calendar, to adopt as much of the climate package as possible in the current reconciliation process before the Senate. This is our last legislative chance for an unknowable amount of time. We believe this moment still represents a historic opportunity to address the climate crisis before it is too late.

While executive action from the Biden administration is helpful and necessary, it is not a substitute for new legislation and the years of certainty that incentives and other investments create. This legislation would fight inflation, slash energy costs for consumers and businesses and deliver a more reliable, stable grid while sharply reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

As the country experiences unprecedented heat waves, flooding, wildfires, drought, and other disasters that will only get worse, we know we simply cannot and must not let this opportunity pass.
